Contributors should submit a clear, errormanuscript (three copies preferred) in the style MLA Style Sheet, second edition. suggested by The AUSLEGUNG subscribes to a blind review policy; the author's name and academic institution should appear only on a detachable cover sheet. Whenever possible, AUSLEGUNG furnishes to contributors copies of the referees' comments.

Book reviews and review articles may be written on books listed in the "Books Available" column. listed in the column may be reviewed if the Book Review Editor is notified and gives approval advance. Anv individual who wishes to review a book should inform the Book Review Editor of the book(s) he she wishes to review. Books will be sent on a first-come first-served basis. Manuscripts cannot be returned unless accompanied by return postage.
