AUSLEGUNG subscribes to a blind review policy; the author's name and academic institution should appear only on a detachable cover sheet. Whenever possible, AUSLEGUNG furnishes copies of the referees' comments to contributors.

Books not listed in the column may be reviewed if the Book Review Editor is notified and gives approval in ad-Any individual who wishes to review a book vance. should inform the Book Review Editor of the book(s) he or she wishes to review.
