Warren's "Guidelines for the Nonsexist Use of Language" in *APA Proceedings* 59 (1986): 471-484. *Auslegung* subscribes to a blind review policy; the author's name and academic institution should appear only on a separate cover sheet. Whenever possible, *Auslegung* furnishes copies of the referees' comments to contributors.

Book reviews and review articles may be written on books listed in the "Books Available" section. Any individual who wishes to review a book should inform the Book Review Editor of the book(s) she or he wishes to review. Books not listed in this section may be reviewed if the Book Review Editor is notified and gives approval in advance.
