

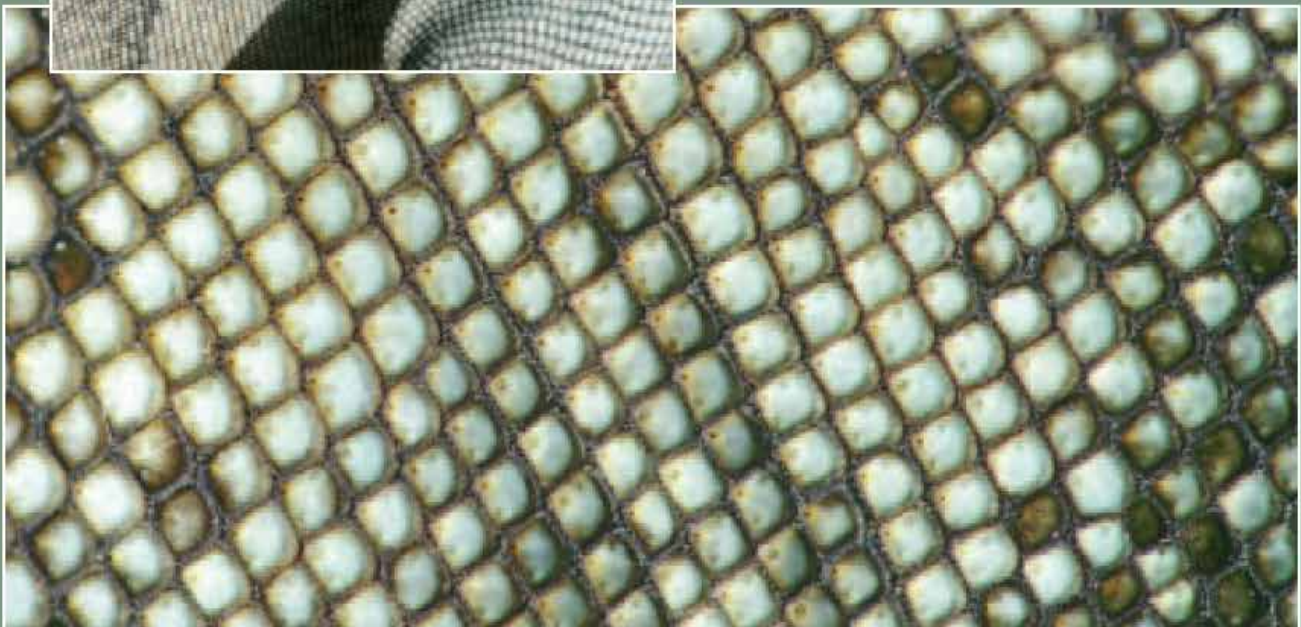


Young, sexually mature male *Cyclura lewisi*.

Viewed closely, the dark chevrons, a residual part of the juvenile pattern, are a mosaic of dark and pale blue scales.
