South Leeward Dwarf Geckos (*Sphaerodactylus fantasticus*) are Lesser Antillean endemics, but the subspecies *S.f. fuga* is endemic to Dominica. These small diurnal geckos are sexually dimorphic. Males have a dark head with light spots, whereas heads of females have two light stripes that extend onto the body.
