
FRENCH ANDROS IGUANAS

John Bendon writes from the south of France, where he has been keeping iguanas in captivity for a number of years. He has bred *Iguana iguana* and kept Rhino Iguanas, *Cyclura cornuta*, but his apparent favorite was a very large Andros Island Iguana, *Cyclura cychlura* (see Iguana Times, Vol. 1, No. 3). He was very tame and would patiently wait by the front door to go for a walk in the garden. This animal was one of the few of his species to ever be in captivity in Europe. He weighed twenty-two pounds at the time of his death, and his remains were donated to the Natural History Museum of London.
