

First Record of Siebold's Watersnake, Ferania sieboldii (Schlegel 1837), from Tripura, India

In India, Siebold's Watersnake, Ferania sieboldii (Schlegel 1837), has been recorded from Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, Nagaland, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Assam, Delhi, Mizoram, and Kerala (Smith 1943; Sharma 2003; Whitaker and Captain 2004; Thakur and Watve 2009; Lalremsangaet al. 2011; Srivastava et al. 2020).

Herein we record *F. sieboldii* from the state of Tripura. Around 1020 h on 21 November 2021, we encountered a *F. sieboldii* on the bank of the River Gomati (Fig. 1) in the Chanban area of Udaipur Town in the State of Tripura, India (23.54527 N, 91.48472 E). The snake, approximately 850 mm in total length, was preying on a Bata Fish (*Labeo bata*).
